Australia to honour veterans for 50th anniversary marking end of combat in Vietnam

Australia's 50th anniversary marking end of combat in Vietnam

The Beaumaris Sub Branch has a number of Vietnam Veterans and will be commemorating through the Long Tan dinner (see next article below). However, the Australian government has committed \$6 million to commemorate and honour Vietnam veterans including the awarding of a <u>medallion</u> on the 50th anniversary marking the end of Australian involvement in Vietnam, according to Andrew Gee, Australia's minister for veterans' affairs and defence personnel. Commemorations began in January 2023—50 years after the Jan. 11, 1973, announcement that Australian combat operations in Vietnam had ended, although some soldiers remained behind to guard the embassy in Saigon until the beginning of July. A total of 60,000 Australians served in Vietnam, with 521 killed and 3,000 wounded.

Australia's commemoration will be undertaken in Canberra on the anniversary of the Long Tan Battle on 18th of August 2023. <u>National Commemorative Service | Department of</u> <u>Veterans' Affairs (dva.gov.au)</u>

JAMES 'JIMMY' SPOTSWOOD: SEP 1923 – JUNE 2023

Our much-loved James 'Jimmy' Spotswood, has passed away at the ripe old age of 99 years & 9 months. His aim had been to get to the Century mark in September but he 'did a Bradman' and left the game with an average score of 99.9.

Jim joined the Navy when he turned 18 in 1941 and served in ships and shore establishments during the War including a posting in HMAS Diamantina. Like many ex-servicemen he bought a block of land with his wife in Beaumaris during land auctions where he lived for the next 60 years.

Jim was extremely active in the Sub-Branch and helped establish the Beaumaris Football Club. He is survived by his Grand Children who provided a very moving and joyous farewell at this funeral.
