Peter Corfield was also confirmed as our welfare officer and acknowledged on all the work he and his wife Rhonda do for our veterans. All of our volunteers and the Women's Auxiliary were also recognized and we look forward to working with everyone again this year.

State Branch and our Debt Resolution Update

For those who are subscribers to the State RSL newsletter you would have read about the recent departures of staff at ANZAC House. One of these was Luke Gilholme who was performing the role of Strategy and Governance. The CEO stated that due to the ceasing of operations of clubs across Victoria and the resulting lack of income restructuring and redundancies were required.

Luke in his former role as acting CFO and in his current position assisted our Sub-branch significantly culminating in the proposal presented to the State Board we reported on in our last newsletter. Although it was not successful it did provide a very clear pathway forward which we are currently stepping gently through.

State Branch is working through considerable challenges during this time and we as a Subbranch have taken this into account and have assumed a 'watching brief' on our debt resolution project. Once the major clubs reopen for business, the state branch moves from crisis management to a more stable footing we believe, and our case will be positively progressed.

Long Term Accommodation Project

Since the closure of the Beaumaris Sports Club your sub-branch through the business planning sub committee has been involved in almost weekly meetings with the Council and the clubs. This work has led to a number of high level concepts from one of the clubs taking on the head lease, the 3 clubs returning to a 6 month and 6 month seasonal lease, the Sub Branch take on the head lease with the support from the 3 clubs and the current proposal of a joint venture between the Football and Cricket clubs taking on the head lease.

All this work has been valuable and necessary to stress test ideas and concepts and one positive outcome from the COVID 19 lock downs there is plenty of time to do this work.

At this stage none of the concepts have moved to a more formal proposal stage. Our Subbranch remains steadfast in securing a lease that complies with the Patriotic Fund Trust rules. Having a secure commercial lease permits us to withdraw funds to support our members. This includes rent, a fit out to properly display and not just our memorabilia but also the sports clubs and providing office space and the like. Our model includes the facility being professionally run supporting the kitchen and importantly supporting the three foundation sports clubs.

As always, we will call a meeting of members when we need to and vote on the matter but unfortunately at this stage we believe it, will be sometime away before we need to do so.
