MEMBERS NEWS

Dear Member

Reporting the Sub-Branch news and events this April, must be one of the most unusual in our Sub-Branch history. The pandemic has changed the way we commemorate ANZAC Day, how we hold meetings, elections and catch up with each other, but we are adapting at overcoming these challenges and the others we are confronted with. On that note we reported last month that State Branch executive had provided us with a proposal to resolve our debt. Unfortunately, this month we have been informed (details below) that the elected Board did not support the proposal. On top of that we have also been advised that the lease at the Beaumaris Sports Club is being changed.

Your committee has become accustomed to challenges and I know our members have too. Beating adversity, staying the course and keeping a sense of humor in dark times are traits in the DNA of Australia's defence forces and from our perspective, the Beaumaris RSL.

Debt Resolution Update

The BRSL received a letter from the CEO of State Branch Mr. Jamie Twidale last week advising the proposal to resolve our debt had been presented to the State RSL board and was not supported. The letter is attached.

On the 26th of March we received a proposal from State Branch that resolved our historic debt. It involved our club making a donation of over \$3 million and was conditional on the State Board approval and our sub-branch members approval. The negotiations leading up to this proposal had been thorough and included advice from Consumer Affairs Victoria and Australian Charities and Not for Profits Commission.

Due to very short time frames in good faith we undertook a consultative process with our members using a variety of tools including phone calls, video conferencing and emails

At the end of the consultative process we have had strong support with the proposal from our members. It was very pleasing to be able to use video conferencing effectively and be able to present the proposal and answer and discuss questions.

Although the committee is very disappointed in the unexpected decision of the State Board we accept it. We have communicated to the CEO that we are still very much open and willing to continue discussions and seek a resolution to this matter. We feel progress will be made in shorter timeframes than we have become unfortunately accustomed to.

Long Term Accommodation Project

We have been informed by Council that the Beaumaris Sports Club's lease at Banksia Reserve has come to an end. The Council is now discussing with the 3 sporting clubs and the Sub-Branch on new accommodation arrangements both short and long term.

The current CONVID 19 restrictions on licensed clubs provides time to undertake these discussions in an orderly and comprehensive manner. Your committee remains confident that our new headquarters will be secured during this process and we will keep you informed of any developments.

ANZAC DAY 2020

Beaumaris RSL is calling members at 5.55am to Stand To in your driveway, balcony or doorway to commemorate this years ANZAC Day. The ABC on TV, Radio and on-line will begin broadcasting from 5-30am and play the Last Post and Ode at 6am.
