Visit to the MUSEUM OF HMAS CERBERUS

Followed by a Matinee Performance of the Royal Australian Navy Band Melbourne. Big Band Concert

Members of the Beaumaris RSL Sub Branch Inc have been invited to join Beaumaris Probus Club, on their upcoming visit to the MUSEUM of HMAS CERBERUS on WED03OCT18.

At this stage, the plan is to travel in Private Motor Vehicles, unless there are sufficient expressions of interest to hire a Coach. One idea, would be to meet at the Beaumaris Sports Club Car Park and work out how many PMV's would be necessary to transport those attending. Say 4 per vehicle. Travel time is approx. 70minutes.

The Plan: Our member, Andy Coogan is the Point of Contact (POC) for both Beaumaris Probus and Beaumaris RSL Sub Branch Inc.

HMAS CERBERUS is the largest Training Establishment in the Royal Australian Navy and is situated in Western Port, Victoria. Access is gained by the West Gate, off South Beach Road, Bittern.

It will be necessary to enter the depot in convoy and when approaching the inner West Gate, pull over to the left and waiting Wilson Security Officers will arrange your entry. They will ring me and I will drive down and escort the convoy to the Museum precinct. For this to work smoothly, the convoy must enter together and arrive at the same time. This has been set at 0900.

Everyone attending will need photo ID. A Driver's licence will be sufficient.

Defence Bases throughout the Commonwealth are now at "Safe Base Charlie" which means that security is treated with a high level of importance.

Suggested programme: On arrival, park cars and enter the Museum Cinema for a welcome and a short film on the RAN.

This will be followed by Morning Tea in the "Vietnam Café" near the Parade Ground.

On completion, a short wander through the adjacent HMAS SYDNEY room and the Quarterdeck Art Gallery.

Then onto the Museum itself, for a guided tour. We travel from Colonial times to the present.

On completion, the two adjacent churches are well worth a look.

A boxed lunch will be served in the Vietnam Café at 1230 and at 1330 we will move in an escorted convoy to the Southern Cross Theatre so that we can be seated in our reserved seats in plenty of time for the afternoon performance of the RAN Band "Sound Waves" Concert, that commences at 1400. The Concert usually finishes at about 1515.

Parking: Behind the Hospital or as directed.
